By now you would have received your 2009 Assessment Notice and you may be wondering what it all means. Here is an example of what an assessment notice looks like:

TAKE NOTICE that you have been assessed as above for the year indicated and should you consider yourself wrongly assessed, you may lodge an appeal using the form below within 60 days after the date of this notice, when the same will be heard by the Board of Revision, of which sitting due notice will be given.

1. This is your legal address.
2. This is your civic address, street number & name.
3. This is your Alternate Number, you need this number if you would like to contact SAMA regarding your property.
4. This is your roll number, this number is used for paying your taxes online or through your bank.
5. This is your taxable assessment. This is what your 2009 levy will be based on.
6. This is the assessment from 2008, this is what your taxes were based on last year.

To calculate your approximate taxes for 2009 do the following:

Municipal: Total assessment X 0.0275 (If below \$625.00 you will pay \$625.00)

School: Total assessment X 0.0108

Add the two figures together to get the total.

Using the example to the left

Municipal: 1190 X 0.0275 = \$32.73, because this is below the minimum tax the municipal portion will be \$625.00

School: 1190 X 0.0108 = \$12.85

Total Taxes: (Approximate): \$637.85

Please note that these tax figures are approximate as the budget and mill rate have not been set for 2009, this is based on the 2008 mill rate of 27.5.
