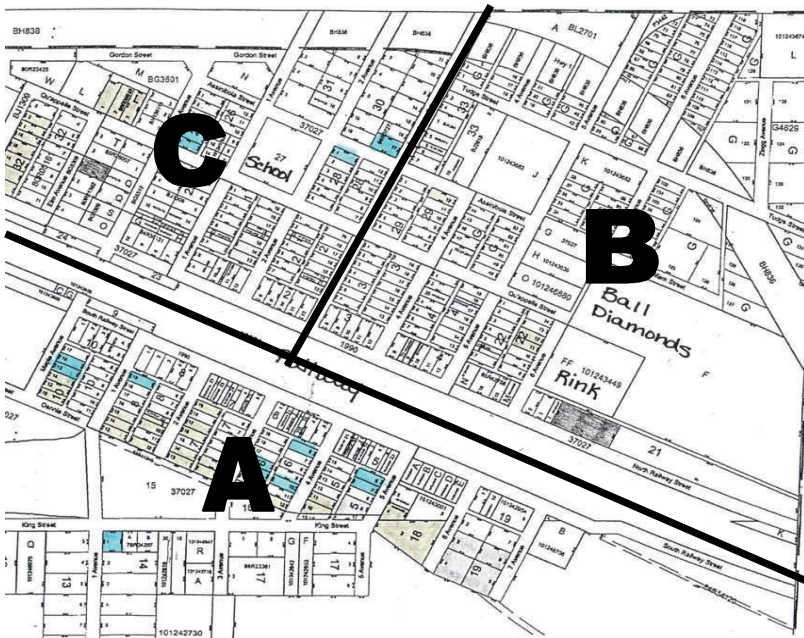

- A. South of Railroad Tracks.
- B. North of Tracks east of Third Avenue.
- C. North of Tracks west of Third Avenue.

 B: Tuesday & Fridays
 C: Wednesdays & Saturdays.
